

FROM ENNERDALE BRIDGE:

- Head North for Kirkland,
- 0.6 miles after you leave the village of Ennerdale Bridge take the right turn down a single-track made-up road (Don't take the first unmade track $\frac{1}{4}$ mile outside the village).
- There are signs at the junction of the single-track made-up road but look for the remains of an old barn and a timber footpath signpost on the corner of the main road and the lane.
- Follow the single-track road for 0.5m.
- At Stoneywath Farm take the turning on right signposted "Ghyll Farm" follow the track for further 0.5miles up to the top of the hill.

FROM KIRKLAND:

- Head for Ennerdale Bridge,
- 0.6 miles after you leave the village of Kirkland take the (first) left turn down a single-track made-up road.
- There are signs at the junction but look for the remains of an old barn and a timber footpath signpost on the corner of the main road and the lane.
- Follow the single-track road for 0.5m.
- At Stoneywath Farm take the turning on right signposted "Ghyll Farm" follow the track for further 0.5miles up to the top of the hill.
